
In this connection, it is informed that Board of Governors of Haryana State Technical Education Society (HSTES) has decided in its 19th meeting held under the Chairmanship of Sh. Anil Malik, IAS, Principal Secretary to Technical Education, Govt. of Haryana regarding admission to MCA, MBA & M.Tech courses from the session 2017-18 onwards that:

MCA: Admission to MCA course shall be made by the concerned University for its affiliated colleges strictly according to the State Reservation Policy at University level or by allowing Institutions at their own level with full transparency and on merit either on the basis of any recognized test or on the basis of own entrance test conducted by the University or on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination such that available/approved capacity is fully utilized.

MBA: Admission to MBA course shall be made by the concerned University/ institutes for its affiliated colleges strictly according to the State Reservation Policy at University level or by allowing Institutions at their own level with full transparency and on merit, firstly on the basis of CMAT score (or any other AICTE recognized test score) and thereafter on the remaining vacant seats if any, on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination such that available/ approved capacity is fully utilized.

M.Tech: The previous practice to be followed for admission to M.Tech courses. The sectioned intake of M.Tech Courses be reduced from the session 2017-18.

It is, further, informed that all the Universities shall make admissions as per the reservation policies of the State Govt. All Self-Financing Technical Institutes under your kind control may be informed accordingly. The letter issued regarding admission to M.Tech. courses in the session 2016-17 is also attached herewith for kind reference please.




Subject: Regarding Admission to M.Tech course for the session 2016-17.

Kindly refer to the subject noted above.

In this connection, it is informed that Board of Governors of Haryana State Technical Education Society (HSTES) has decided in its 18th meeting held under the Chairpersonship of Smt. Dheera Khandelwal, the then ACSTE, Govt. of Haryana that:

"The admission to M.Tech courses be made by the concerned University in respect of colleges affiliated to it firstly on the basis of GATE score and thereafter on the remaining vacant seats if any, on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. The universities may fix their respective admission schedule in consultation with each other so that the institute level admission dates may not clash."

It is, further, informed that all the Universities shall make admissions as per the reservation policies of the State Govt. All Self-Financing Technical Institutes under your kind control may be informed accordingly.
