

**Subject: Minimum Academic Qualifications for B.Arch:**

- i. **10+2 or equivalent from a recognized Board/University with Mathematics as subjects of examination and also obtained at least 50% aggregate marks in 10+2 level examination.**

Or

Candidates with 10+3 Diploma (any stream) recognized by central / State Governments with mathematics as compulsory subject and obtained with 50% in aggregate marks.

Or

International Baccalaureate Diploma, after 10 years of schooling, with not less than 50% marks in aggregate and with Mathematics as compulsory subject of Examination. Merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of 10+2 and NATA score in the ratio 50:50.

- ii. Merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of 10+2 and valid NATA score (percentage) or score (percentage) of qualified JEE (Main) Paper-2 -2017 (B. Arch./B.Planning) in the ratio 50:50.
- iii. In order to pass NATA Test a candidate must valid NATA Score as per COA.

**Obtained at least 50% marks (47.5% in case of candidate belonging to SC category) in the qualifying Examination.**
